



Company director Dean Randle says relocating his business to Castledown Enterprise Centre has been a really good move.

His firm Corporate LinX Ltd was founded five years ago and uses specially-developed software to help big corporate clients like Airbus, large retail chains, and others to reduce costs and optimise working capital in the way their supply chains operate.

Until July 2013, Dean ran the UK side of the Anglo-French company from home in Appleshaw, near Ludgershall, until the firm’s growth forced him to find new business premises.

Corporate LinX Ltd now employs four people at Castledown Enterprise Centre and aims to extend its services to small and medium-sized businesses locally.

His was the first business to move into the new Enterprise Centre. “I really like the design of it, particularly the large communal area which encourages you to meet other people working here,” said Dean.
